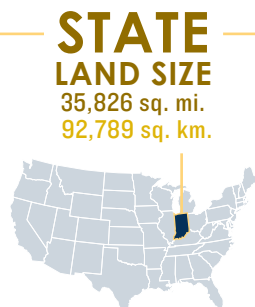

*Corporate Income Tax rate is decreasing from the current 7.5% to 6.5% for 2015 through 0.5% per year reductions. Next decrease scheduled for July 2014 to 7%.

**Individual income tax rate is decreasing from the current 3.4% to 3.3% for 2015/2016 and 3.23% for 2017 and beyond.

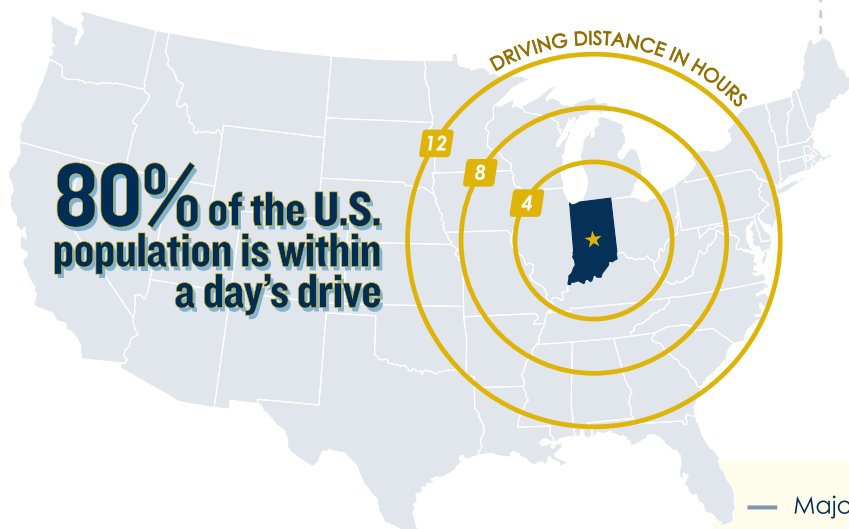
From 2010-2012, manufacturing was the most popular business activity for foreign investment in Indiana, comprising 74% of all expected jobs compared to 44.8% nationally.

AIR

Indianapolis International Airport is the 5TH largest cargo airport and is home to the 2ND largest FedEx hub worldwide

RAIL

1ST in the U.S. for rail tons of primary metal products originated and 3RD in the U.S. for total freight railroads

ROAD

1ST in the U.S. for pass-through highways

WATER

With 3 international ports and 407 miles of navigable waterways, Indiana is home to the only statewide port system providing international connections for America's Heartland via the Great Lakes and Ohio-Mississippi river system.
